

Selective Service

Male who lived in U.S .between ages 18 and 26?

- If yes, then the applicant should have registered for the Selective Service and should provide his Selective Service number and date of registration.
 - All men between the ages of 18 and 31 are required to present proof of registration when applying for Citizenship.
 - Applicant can confirm registration at sss.gov.

Male under 26 that has not registered for Selective Service?

Must register at sss.gov or fill out registration form before applying.

Male that lived in US between ages 18 and 26, BUT is currently between ages 26 and 31?

- <u>If the applicant registered</u> for the Selective Service, he must provide Selective Service number and date of registration.
- If the applicant did not register, then he must attach a statement explaining why he failed to register for the Selective Service.
 - ➤ If the applicant did not know he had to register, addenda is available with explanation.
- A status update letter from the Selective Service is required for males currently aged 26 to 31.

Male that lived in US between ages 18 and 26, BUT is currently over 31?

- <u>If the applicant registered</u> for the Selective Service, he must provide Selective Service number and date of registration.
- If the applicant did not register, then he must attach a statement explaining why he failed to register for the Selective Service.
 - ➤ If the applicant did not know he had to register, addenda is available with explanation.
