REQUEST TO WAIVE THE OATH OF ALLEGIANCE

Dear USCIS:

In accordance with the USCIS Policy Manual, I am providing this request to waive the Oath of Allegiance for the above applicant.¹

I hereby affirm that the applicant is unable to undergo any part of the naturalization examination because of a physical or developmental disability or mental impairment and that I am able to act on the applicant's behalf to complete the naturalization process.

I am eligible to act on the applicant's behalf because I am the applicant's:

- Legal Guardian or surrogate, and I am authorized by a proper court to exercise legal authority over the applicant's affairs.
- U.S. citizen spouse, parent, child, or sibling, and I am the applicant's primary custodial caregiver and take responsibility for the applicant.

In addition to this request, I will provide an evaluation by an authorized medical professional to establish the applicant's inability to take the oath.
