



Citizenship for Your Children

If you have children under the age of 18, they may become U.S. Citizens when you become a U.S. Citizen.

To become a citizen, your children must:

- Be under 18 years old
- Be legal permanent residents (green card holders)
- Currently live with you

If all of those things are true, Project Citizenship can help you apply for a Certificate of Citizenship for your children once you become a citizen.

You will need:

- Your child's green card
- Your child's birth certificate
- Proof of your U.S. Citizenship
- Your birth certificate
- Proof of parent's custody
- \$1,170 (unless eligible for a fee waiver)
