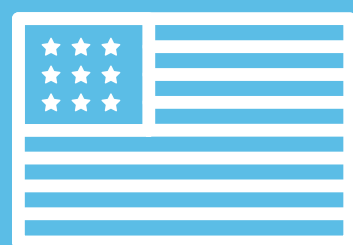

CITIZENSHIP MATTERS



Our work lies at the intersection of social justice, democracy building, and economic vitality. Citizenship is patriotism of the highest order. By extending the benefits of citizenship to permanent residents, we increase economic stability, health care access, educational opportunities, and civic engagement in our communities. This inclusive participation is essential for the health of our democracy.

THE NEED

90% of eligible immigrants do not apply for citizenship; due to lack of motivation, knowledge, the expense, a confusing naturalization process, and a host of other reasons. Our foreign-born population drives and invigorates our local economies; holds over half the Ph.D.'s in the state; comprises 17% of our workforce; and contributes as students, workers, taxpayers, and home- and business-owners.

OUR MISSION

Project Citizenship is a nonprofit agency that seeks to increase the naturalization rate in Massachusetts and beyond. We provide free, high quality, legal services to eligible immigrants to help them become U.S. citizens.



WHO WE ARE

Project Citizenship works collaboratively with community-based partners to help eligible, permanent residents overcome barriers to becoming U.S. citizens. We believe that citizenship has a transformative impact on the individual, family, community and our nation as a whole.

OUR MODEL



Project Citizenship relies heavily upon trained volunteers to provide cost efficient services to citizenship applicants. Project Citizenship has more than 1,130 active volunteers: over 200 *pro bono* attorneys and more than 250 law student volunteers from Boston's area law schools.

OUR ROOTS

Project Citizenship began as the Greater Boston Citizenship Initiative, a collaboration of community partners in Massachusetts seeking to increase naturalization rates in Massachusetts. The Initiative was created by a committed group of immigrant, community-based, and direct service organizations to educate immigrants about the benefits of citizenship.

IMPACT

Since 2014, Project Citizenship has assisted 16,000 immigrants from 169 countries of origin. Over 9,000 have submitted citizenship applications. 73% of our clients are essential workers; 70% qualify for fee-waivers.
