RE: Letter Requesting Waiver of Oath of Allegiance for [APPLICANT] (DOB:)

Dear [Medical Professional]:

Dr. [Name] previously completed the form N-648: Medical Certification for Disabilityu Exceptions on behalf of Mr./Mrs [Name], based on his/her diagnosis of [condition]. The waiver was accepted by USCIS, and Mr./Mrs. [Name] was not required to take the English or civics test during his/her naturalization interview.

Before [Applicant] is granted citizenship, USCIS requires a letter from [Medical Professional] explaining that he/she is unable to understand and meaningfully take the oath of allegiance given her intellectual disabilities. The letter should explain that, due to her intellectual disabilities, [Applicant] does not have the mental capacity to understand the complexities of the oath of allegiance to the United States. It should also request that [Applicant] be excused from the requirement of taking a meaningful oath. The letter must be signed by [Medical Professional] and must include his/her state license number. Once written, please send the original signed copy to the address above, as soon as possible.
